1. Is there anything you learned this week about the story of Israel that you didn't know before? Anything that surprised you?

2. Read the whole chapter of Ezekiel 37 together. How does the first half of the chapter (verses 1-14) influence or shape how you read the second half of the chapter (verses 15-28)?

3. How does the prophecy of Ezekiel connect to our current series on the Fruit of the Spirit?

4. It is easy to think of us belonging to God, but have you ever wrestled with the idea that God belongs to you, too? How has God promised He will take care of you?

5. If we have been given the message of reconciliation through Christ, how do you see that playing itself out in your life? In your family's life?

6. Where do you need to say, "I'm sorry"? Where do you need to say, "I forgive you"?
