FINDING FAVOR

Revelation 1:1-4

1. Since this is the first gathering of the new year, catch up on everyone's Christmases. In addition, have any new members introduce themselves.

2. "Blessing" is a hard word to define. Doug said we often use it these days as if it means the same thing as "lucky." How is it different? How would you describe what it means to be "blessed" to a friend?

3. Turn to Revelation 1 and read vss. 1-3. What stood out to you the most from this week's message? Did anything surprise you?

4. Note the repetition of the word "blessed" in vs. 3. It refers to the double blessing for both church leaders and members as they proclaim and respond to the Bible. (I'm guessing no one has ever *hashtagged-blessed* this kind of blessing) Why do you suppose this is the first blessing mentioned in Revelation? How might someone experience this blessing?

5. Doug mentioned that living in an information-saturated world, we need something to curate our knowledge. Give an example of how the Bible can be an information filter for the believer.

6. I imagine most believers want to read the Bible more. What are the biggest obstacles for you?

7. Now look back at the list you made in question 6. Next to each obstacle, see if you can come up with a solution.

8. What is the biggest takeaway for you from this week's message? How might your group be able to pray for and encourage you in that?
