### **Recapturing a Place for God**

*Matthew 21:9-17*

1. When you see something wrong, are you more likely to error on the side of acting without thinking, or thinking without acting?
2. Read Matthew 21:9-17. What stood out to you the most from this week's message? What would you like to talk about further with your group?
3. What offended Jesus in vs. 12-13? No doubt the merchants felt they were providing a useful service to the worshippers. What blinded them from the true purpose of the Temple?
4. Look at Isaiah 56:3-7. What was God's original intention for the Temple?
5. Compare the above passage with 1 Corinthians 6:19-20. What was God's intention for YOU as His temple today?
6. Jesus considers YOU His dwelling place (His house). If you're willing to be vulnerable, where might Jesus turn over some tables in your life?
7. What part of your life do you feel Jesus might want to recapture as we approach Easter? A place for prayer? A place for people? A place for praise? Other?
