*Psalm 8*

1. Introduce any new members in your group. Catch up on any big news from your summers.
  
2. Take a moment to make a verbal covenant as a group. What do you hope to accomplish this session? What is your purpose? How will you approach attendance, confidentiality, time boundaries for the meetings, prayer requests, dessert, etc.
  
3. Read Psalm 8 and review the outline. When was a time in your life when you were naturally and spontaneously moved to praise God?
  
4. What moves you to worship now?
  
5. Look at vs. 1 and vs. 9. The title, "LORD, our Lord," implies that God is our Leader and Ruler who controls all things and is ever present and everywhere. How does that change your attitude as you approach him in worship?
  
6. Look at verses 3-4. The wonder of Christianity is that the God who made Jupiter cares about the smallest details of your day. And the God who designed the Northern Lights is orchestrating plans for your future. It's mind boggling. What does that reveal about God? What does it say about humankind?
  
7. What does the role God has given to women and men as the crown of His creation say about the dignity of humanity? What does it say about our responsibility?
  
8. How does praise change us?
  
9. What lies are silenced when we worship?
