2. Review John 10:22-29. What points from the message and the passage made an impact on you? Why was this important to you?

3. Look at the five "sheepish ways" under point 1. In what area(s) are believers most prone today? Give some real examples.

4. What are some of the reasons a believer might worry about making it to heaven? If they were a friend of yours, what would you tell them from this passage? What is most comforting to you? Why?

5. Do you agree that once a person is a believer that they cannot mess up their eternal destiny? How does your opinion jive with this passage?

6. How do you account for the fact that some people seem to make a genuine commitment to Christ and then walk away?

7. Does knowing you are secure in God's grip make you more complacent or committed? Why?

8. Which of the three spiritual skills at the end of the message could you work on this week? What would it look like?
