2 CHOICES YOU NEED TO GET RIGHT

- Will you listen to God or yourself **?**

Jeremiah 33:4-19 (esp. vss 10-11)

3 REMINDERS WITH EVERY SUNRISE

- Like the sunrise, God's goodness is timely

Jeremiah 33:20-21

- Like the sunrise, God's goodness is reliable

Jeremiah 33:22

- Like the sunrise, God's goodness is incredible

3. Read Jeremiah 33 and review the message outline. What point(s) stood out for you?

5. How might we apply vss. 6-9 to what Jesus did for us?
6. Are you more inclined to turn toward God or away in struggles?
7. Which of the three reminders with every sunset do you need to remember right now?
