1. What one hit wonders do you recall?
2. Read Luke 13:10-17 and review the outline. What fresh insights did you get from this conflict between Jesus and the synagogue leader?
3. Who do you relate to most in this story? The suffering woman who was healed? Jesus who was misunderstood? The opponents who were bothered?
4. How does Jesus expose the religious leaders' hypocrisy?
5. What is the real intent of the Sabbath according to this passage (compare Mark 2:27-28) ?
6. Do you have a *go-to* verse that you find yourself using all the time in conversation? What is it? How could it become unbalanced without the rest of Scripture?
7. How does it change the way we think about the Bible when we see it more like a mirror than binoculars? Notice that Jesus, in Matt 7:5, implies that only after we use the Bible as a mirror can we use it as binoculars.
8. Which of the 4 Questions at the bottom of the outline would you like to incorporate more in your Bible reading?
9. How does asking, *What does this reveal about the heart of God?*, add richness to studying a passage? Explain.
