3. What do you think the Pharisees around the table were thinking in vs. 7-11 (nothing is recorded)?
4. How does Jesus' instructions to the host (Luke 14:12-14) connect with the earlier story in Luke 14:1-6?
5. God's People should take a posture of humility. What is Jesus' rationale for this in vs. 11? Beyond the dinner party setting, what are some current situations where you can take a posture of humility?
6. God's People should help elevate those who are needy and humble. What is Jesus' rationale for this in vs. 14? What are some ways believers can elevate those whom life has humbled?
7. What does this passage tell us about Kingdom values?
8. EXTRA CREDIT: Read ahead (Luke 14:15-24). How does this parable connect with Jesus' instructions in the passage from the sermon?
