1. Are you more likely to snack on sweet or salty? Morning or midnight muncher? Churros or cheesecake?
2. When it comes to sharing your faith, does the thought of it make you feel energized or guilty? Or other? Explain.
3. What was your impression (if any) of the Great Commission before this message? How did it change?
4. Read Matt 28:16-20 and review the outline. How does Jesus' commission here differ from His earlier commission of His disciples in Matt 10:5-7?
5. How does it change your understanding of Jesus' words in this passage to know that some of His disciples there that day had doubts (vs. 17)? Jesus apparently activates us to His service even when we are still in process. Is that a good idea?
6. What does it mean to you to “Use this lens: Who has God brought into my life with a receptive heart?” How is receptivity a healthy gauge when it comes to sharing your faith?
7. Doug said, *“To share your faith, you don't have to make a special trip overseas, travel across the border, or leave your time zone. When Jesus says GO! He means ‘wherever you go.’”* Is there anyone in your life right now that you can come alongside in your journey of faith and invite to follow Jesus with you?
8. Look again at Jesus' definition of being a disciple in vss. 19-20. How would you define what it means to be a full-fledged disciple according to Jesus? Why?
