Matthew 4:18-22 | Sept 11, 2022

1. Welcome to your new (or returning) HomeGroup! Write down one thing you'd like to tell your group about your summer. If you're new to your group, what is one glimpse into your summer that reveals something about who you are? You get extra credit if it is a fishing story since it ties into this week's message :)
2. Read Matthew 4:18-22 and review the outline. This passage brings out part of what is essential about being a follower of Jesus. How so?
3. This is Jesus' first "I will" promise in the New Testament. Why do you suppose the Bible starts with this rather than, say, forgiveness or eternal life?
4. God created us to be significant. What evidence do you see that people, believers or not, long for significance?
5. In Jesus' day, fishing was labor-intensive. Rather than using a lure and a line (and waiting for the fish to strike), they used large, heavy nets to pull in the fish. This job involved much strain, long hours, and sometimes little results. How does this first-century fishing analogy speak to our desire to make a difference today?
6. Look at the second meter in your outline. What does it mean for you to value people over products in your career or lifestyle?
7. Peter and Andrew were fishermen so Jesus called them to be spiritual fishers. What might Jesus say to you using your profession?
8. Jesus promised He would "make" us useful. Where do you sense His shaping in your life for Kingdom impact?
9. How can your group pray for you?
