Someone Who Believes in You | *SOMEONE WHO ...*

Acts 9:1-27; 11:25-26 | Nov 6, 2022

1. Have you ever been an intern, apprentice, or trainee for a job? What kind of supervisor did you have?
2. The premise for this series is this: **Beyond just God and family, the Bible reveals 3 core relationships you need.** Is it possible to grow spiritually with just God and family? Explain.
3. Read Acts 9:1-9 and 11:25-26 and think back on the message. What made an impression on you?
4. In Acts 9:25 it says that the disciples in Jerusalem did not believe that Saul was a true Christian. Do you get them, or blame them? Why?
5. The sermon didn't have time to cover Saul's encounter with Ananias. Read about it in Acts 9:10-19. Ananias' name means, *The Lord is gracious*. How is that revealed to Saul? Give specific examples.
6. Do a word search for Barnabas in the Book of Acts. What else do we know about him? How are his actions with Saul consistent throughout?
7. Barnabas' actions in Acts 11:25-26 were extraordinary. What would have made the biggest impression on the apostles? How about Saul?
8. Do you have a spiritual mentor, or mentors, in your life right now? Who? If not, is there someone you are thinking about asking?
9. How can your group pray for you?
