- 1. What skill or knack have you been good at from an early age?
- 2. What is one thing that makes you unique from everyone else in your HomeGroup?
- 3. Read Romans 12:6-8 and review the outline and the message. What stuck with you from the message?
- 4. Why do you think people can so easily default to copying others rather than being true to who God made them? Where is the line between learning from the model of others and copying others?
- 5. This passage reminds us that God gave us gifts as an expression of His grace to us. How do we experience God's grace when we know and use our gifts?
- 6. Look at the gifts in the chart in the middle of the outline. What do you think are some gifts you have?
- 7. How could your spiritual gifts show up in everyday life, that is, during any of the 167 hours outside of church?
- 8. Joy is linked to the gift of mercy in this passage (vs. 8). It is also linked to the gift of giving (See 2 Cor. 9:7). Why is joy so important when it comes to using our gifts to serve others?
- 9. Which of the 7 Ways to Leverage your Impact would be best for you to focus on this week? Explain.
