



- 5. What do you think Paul meant by a veil over the hearts of the Israelites when they read the Old Testament law? Does this mean that God's Word isn't clear to those outside the faith? If not, what does it mean?
- 6. According to vs. 3:18, what are the wonderful outcomes for those who contemplate the Lord's glory (in His word and Creation)?
- 7. 2 Cor. 4:6 compares God's work at Creation with God's work in us now. Read Genesis Chapter 1 and list some of the parallels between what God did at Creation with what God does in His people today.
- 8. Doug said, "I have no brightness in myself. But as God shines in my heart I, too, will radiate His glory." What have you found helps you let Jesus shine through you more?
