- 1. What were phones like when you were a kid? When did you first get a mobile phone?
- 2. How does our culture typically define freedom?
- 3. Read 5:13-15 and review the outline. What points from the message stood out for you?
- 4. According to Galatians 5:13 (and 5:1), God wants you to be free. How is that different than culture's perspective of God? Is it different than your earliest understandings of God as well?
- 5. Can you think of examples where people indulge themselves resulting in them feeling trapped or burdened?
- 6. According to vs. 13, how does God's path to freedom differ from the world's? How does our culture view serving others? Highly? With contempt? Other?
- 7. How does serving others lead to love, as described in Galatians 5:14? Have you experienced this in your own life?
- 8. In what areas of your life do you feel the tension between cultural freedom and God's freedom? How can you move toward God's path of freedom?
- 9. How can your group pray for you?
