1. Jesus never asks us to give more than what we have right now.

 God has designed you with <u>intention</u>, crafting you in His image and <u>equipping</u> you for a specific purpose.


2. Jesus multiplies the impact of what we already have.

- 3. What does it look like for you to trust God with your limited resources—whether time or energy—and allow Him to use them for His glory this week?
- 4. What are some ways that you have seen God provide for you in your life?
- 5. When you're feeling drained or tired this week, like the apostles, what are some ways you can remind yourself that God is asking you to give what you have right now?
- 6. Have you ever seen God multiply your impact through something you have done? How so?
- 7. What can you do this week to make a meaningful impact on the Kingdom?
- 8. Share any prayer requests and take time to pray and reflect on what God has provided for you.
